SANJAT is a team of 23 young percussionists of both genders whose training is supervised by Hussain Al Harbi. The name refers to the circular metal piece at the end of a tambourine and can only be found on percussion instruments. The band presents original musical pieces, written by Hussain Al Harbi with a special and different rhythmic style. They employ rhythmic music in a way that reflects the diverse cultural depth of Iraq. SANJAT believes that real change in a society comes from a direct contact. Therefore, musical performances are presented in public place.


